- 1) Personal statement in preferred language answering the following in 500-750 words.
 - a) career plans and goals;
 - b) personal, community and academic achievements;
 - c) reasons for applying for the scholarship; and, if applicable
 - d) any obstacles that were overcome during school years.
- 2) An official transcript (unofficial will not be accepted)
- 3) Two different letters of recommendation from a past employer, supervisor, teacher, faculty or staff who can provide information about your past/current employment, civic engagement, and/or ability to lead. (no family member letters)

Application Deadline: Postmarked no later than March 16, 2012.
