Modified Program for Special Education Students

The Cascade School District will use the guidelines developed by the Idaho Department of Education in its *Idaho Special Education Manual* regarding special education issues. The *Idaho Special Education Manual, 2007*, is designed to assist Idaho school districts to understand the provisions of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act and meet the guidelines contained with the law.

If the need arises with special education students due to the failing of certain required courses, a modified program may be set up in the best interests of the student whereby he/she may be given the opportunity to learn by taking into consideration the handicap and/or learning problem. This must be done on an individual basis with the joint efforts of the special education teacher, the classroom teacher and the counselor, with the approval of the parents and the principal. Daily assignments and tests will be supplied by the classroom teacher and grades will be given by him/her.
