

School Sponsored Student Activities Procedure

Activities on the School Calendar

All organizational activities must be on the Official School Calendar. An activity slip must be turned in to the office of the Principal or Superintendent at least four (4) days prior to the date of the activity, preferably earlier.

The activity slip must be properly filled out and signed by the advisor of the organization before it is turned in to the office. These activity slips may be obtained in the Principal's office.

School Dance Regulations

Time

The dance must end no later than twelve (12) midnight.

Band

Any band or DJ that plays at a High School Dance must first be approved by the school administration, and must be under a written contract.

Age

All dances must be designated as:

1. High School only
2. Junior High only

Grade school students will not be allowed to attend any of the above dances.

Junior high students will not be permitted to attend the prom.

Permission **must** be granted by the administrators, before any non-school person may attend any dance. Permission must be requested at least two (2) days before the dance.

Conduct

All persons attending a dance, (regardless of age) will conduct themselves in an appropriate manner.

Drugs

**NO DRINKING WILL BE ALLOWED.** Any person(s) who is under the influence, or suspected of being intoxicated will not be allowed to attend, and referred to the SRO.

#### Leaving

No person(s) shall leave the dance, except in an obvious emergency. Those persons who do leave will be admitted with a second payment. **This is a hard but necessary** procedure because of possible drinking.

#### Chaperones

All dances are to be chaperoned by a minimum of four adults. One must be a female and one must be a male.

The advisor to the sponsoring group will be in charge.

The chaperons have the authority to control lighting, loudness of the band, or any area which they feel is of importance to the climate of the dance.
