

Removal of Student During School Hours

The Board recognizes its responsibility for the proper care of students during school hours. School Hours shall be from the time of the tardy bell in the morning for the first period, till the lunch bell at noon, and then again from the afternoon tardy bell till the last bell of the day. Students shall not be removed from school grounds, any school building or school function during school hours except by a person duly authorized in accordance with District procedures. Before a student is removed or excused, the person seeking to remove the student must present, to the satisfaction of the principal, evidence of his/her proper authority to remove the student. A teacher should not excuse a student from class to confer with anyone unless the request is approved by the principal. Students leaving school grounds during classes or between morning classes or again between afternoon classes will be considered truant, and subject to the rules covering truancy.

Work Permits

Seniors may apply for a work permit with written request to the Principal or Superintendent. A meeting between the student and the Principal or Superintendent will determine the need for a work permit. Work permits may be revoked if the student is not adequately performing his/her duties at the job site or if his/her class marks become unsatisfactory. Students must carry six (6) classes in addition to their work permit.
