

Emergencies Involving Transportation Vehicles

In the event of an accident or other emergency, the bus driver shall follow the emergency procedures developed by the Superintendent. A copy of the emergency procedures shall be located in each bus. To ensure the success of such emergency procedures, each bus driver shall conduct an emergency evacuation drill within the first six (6) weeks of each school semester. The District shall conduct such other drills and procedures as may be necessary.

Emergency or Disaster

- A. The Superintendent or his charge will direct buses and drivers to the appropriate loading areas.
- B. Scheduled runs would be combined into maximum capacity single runs.
- C. District staff would institute crowd control measures to insure safe and efficient loading of students.

Emergency Evacuation

The bus drivers will organize, develop and carry out instructions for students in school bus safety and emergency evacuation. The following skills will be taught at least once a year.

- A. Emergency evacuation through available emergency kits
- B. Safe operation of windows
- C. Awareness and knowledge of posted bus safety rules and regulations
- D. Location and proper use of fire extinguishers
