NOTIFICATION OF DAVE KLUDT - ALC NATURAL RESOURCE 2012 SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Dave Kludt - ALC Natural Resource Scholarship is dedicated in memory of Dave Kludt, former Idaho Logging Safety supervisor, who was killed in a car accident in 2006.

To be eligible for the \$1,000 award, the student must demonstrate that they are related to an ALC Member and planning to attend college or technical school in a field of study that will return them to work in the natural resource arena. Examples of fields of study eligible for this scholarship include: diesel mechanics, truck driving, machine operation, forestry, forestry technician, biology, hydrologist, or law with the intent to practice in the natural resource field in defense of logging and forest management. Other related fields of study will be considered.

We are currently taking applications for this scholarship. The attached application should be completed and returned to Associated Logging Contractors, Inc., P. O. Box 671, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho 83816-0671.

Application checklist -- The following information must be provided for application to be considered:

- Notation of relation to an ALC member and name of the member and member company.
- Notation of whether you are sponsored by an ALC member and, if so, which member.
- Notation of whether you are a member of a family who is working in logging or in the timber industry.

Applications must be submitted and post marked no later than February 29, 2012.

This scholarship will be presented to the chosen applicant at our Annual Convention that will be held at The Red Lion Hotel, Lewiston, Idaho, on April 28, 2012. If applicant is successful, the scholarship will be deposited in the student's account at the school the student plans to attend.
