SCHOLARSHIP

Resolution concerning Lions Scholarship. Whereas, the Cascade Lions are funding an annual scholarship award to a deserving high school student at Cascade High School, be it resolved that:

1. An annual scholarship be established in the amount of \$500.00.
2. The Scholarship funds shall be awarded as follows: The sum of \$250.00 to be paid upon successful completion of the first semester of college, or a similar grading period if the recipient chooses to attend a trade school. Upon successful completion of the second semester, payment of the sum of \$250.00. "Successful completion" is intended to mean completion of at least 8 credit hours and achieving a Grade Point Average of at least 2.25 on a 4.0 scale, to be verified by a certified transcript provided by the educational institution.
3. Any graduating senior from Cascade High School is eligible to compete for and may receive the scholarship.
4. The recipient shall be selected by a committee composed of 5-6 Cascade Lions.
5. The recipient may attend the college or trade school of his or her choice.
6. Criteria for the selection committee's consideration shall be:
 - A: Need
 - B: Academic achievement
 - C: Leadership and participation in extra-curricular activities
7. The committee is also encouraged to seek the counsel of either the High School Principal or the Superintendent of Cascade Schools and consider any recommendations offered by those officials.
8. It is intended for this award to continue on an annual basis. A successful candidate may apply for a second or succeeding years, but must complete and file an application with the Cascade Lions Club no later than May 20th of each succeeding year.

Cascade Lions Club Scholarship Requirements

Eligibility: Graduates of Cascade High School, Spring of 2011.

Amount: To be determined, at a minimum, \$500.00 per academic year.

Criteria for Selection:

Need - based upon family income and number of members in family.

Leadership - based upon demonstrated leadership skills/experience.

Community Service - based upon activities outside of school in the service of others in the community.

Recommendations of two responsible adults, i.e., teacher, minister, or others who know you well.

Applications require name, age, address, transcript reflecting grades earned in high school and data concerning family income and number of members in the immediate family, and the name of the college or trade school to be attended.

Application deadline is May 20, 2011 for the 2010-2011 academic year.

A recipient of this scholarship may reapply for the next year and subsequent years.

"Successful completion" as used above means achieving a grade point average of at least 2.25 on a 4.0 scale and at least 8 credit hours of academic subjects.
