Tuition support for a student from Malheur County. Must be pursuing a career in Criminal Justice, Emergency Services, Fire Science or EMT. Must have at least a 3.0 GPA

Harold & Mika Hiuga Scholarship

Tuition support to a student of Diverse Cultural background. Must have financial need and academic achievement.

Two awards for tuition support to a Malheur County high school graduate. Recipients must have educational goals and a financial need.
